## To all participants

- The lunch break is only about half an hour. The nearest convenience store is a little far away from the venue, so we recommend bringing your own lunch.
- There are some historical buildings on campus. When eating or drinking, please pay attention to whether eating or drinking is allowed in that building.
- On both days of the conference, there will be books for viewing and for sale along with a rest area in room No.142. You may eat and drink in this room if you wish.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere on campus, whether inside or outside the buildings.

## To all presenters (oral and poster presentations)

## To all oral presenters

- The time allotted for each presentation is 35 minutes: 25 min. for presentation and 10 min. for questions and answers.
- In each room, the PC can be connected via a D-Sub 15-pin terminal for video and a mini jack (3.5mm φ) for audio. If you need to connect in other formats such as HDMI, please bring your own adapter.
- Each presenter should check whether his or her equipment can be connected properly ahead of time, during a break.

## To poster presenters

- The poster size must be A0 format with a vertical orientation (height 1189mm \* width 841mm). The width of the poster board is 841mm, so larger sizes cannot be posted.
- Write the presentation number (P1, etc.) at the top of the poster.
- The poster presentation is 14: 50-16:10 on the second day (September 29, Sunday). The first half (14:50-14:3015:30) is for the odd-numbered posters, and the second half (14:3015:30-16:10) is for the even-numbered ones.
- No equipment, such as projectors, will be provided at the poster venue.
